The 9-hole "La Crosse" course at the La Crosse Country Club facility in La Crosse, Kansas features 2,810 yards of golf from the longest tees for a par of 35. La Crosse golf course opened in 1930.

Directions to Club House:

From the North: Go South through town on 183. Turn East on E 3rd St. and South on Peace St.

From the South: Entering town from the south on 183, turn East on E 3rd St. and then South on Peace St.

1. KSHSAA will place golfers in groups of 4 and those pairing will be listed on KSHSAA website the day after Regional Competition is concluded.
2. For the Participants and their Coaches, practice rounds will be free of charge. Teams will be assigned designated practice times for Wednesday May 25. Reminder that the course cannot be used for practice the day of the tournament and no driving range is available.
3. Coaches Meeting: 7:30 a.m. in the club house
4. Tee Off: (Shotgun) at 8:30 a.m.
5. In the event that inclement weather occurs, play will be resumed the following day (Wednesday May 27) at 8:00 a.m. or as soon as the course is deemed ready for play.
6. Markers will be assigned to each participating group.
7. Media and spectators will have 2 designated locations from which they can observe the competition, but will be advised to adhere to the spectator guidelines set by KSHSAA. Media and spectators will not be allowed to walk with groups throughout the course.
8. An arbitration committee for on-site protests will be 1 coach per regional, plus the course pro.
9. KSHSAA State Championship T-Shirts can be preordered and additional shirts will be for sale at the tournament site as well. Cost is \$ 15 per Shirt (\$1.00 more for XXL and \$2.00 for XXXL).
