Aaron McGaughey moved, seconded by Harland Werth that the district will follow KSDE recommendations in regards to the 10x6 rule and approve all students, coach, assistant coach, and bus driver included in contact tracing for the volleyball team (10/3/30) be allowed to return to school/work on Monday, October 12 based on factual evidence presented so long as they exhibit no symptoms and have not had a positive COVID test. The person(s) who are found in violation the 10x6 rule, per contact tracing, must follow RCH direction to continue quarantine as advised. Motion carried 4-0 with two abstentions (GH, SS conflict.)

Policy Addition

Glenn Herrman moved, seconded by Aaron McGaughey to approve the addition of the proposed school activity transportation policy as presented with specification that a parent or guardian must be the one to provide alternate transportation for their student. The district will not reimburse any families for transportation. Motion carried 6-0.
