We are asking you to direct this letter to the appropriate person responsible for disseminating scholarship information to your students. We are sending this to all school districts in the counties in which members of this chapter live. We authorize copying.

Our chapter is once again offering \$1,000 dollar scholarships for post-secondary education or training. We are doing this as a public service and applicants need have no connection to a Vietnam veteran. The full application requirements ***must*** be in our hands by April 24, 2026, in order to be considered. The earlier the better. **PLEASE DO NOT STAPLE**

We are aware that academic scholarships exist in abundance. The criteria for this one are not entirely, or even primarily, academic. Our focus is upon students who have been reasonably conscientious as students, though not necessarily distinguishing themselves in academics. We are interested in students who have been employed for pay during their high school careers. Employment illustrates reliability and a degree of self-discipline, but tends to detract from academic performance at the lighter levels of achievement.

1. The applicant should complete a copy of the attached application form. Important are basic contact information and an essay (a half-page more or less), explaining what kind of post-high school education or training the applicant seeks, and why and how he or she expects to benefit from it. Detailed recommendations from two teachers, and recommendations from one or more employers should be directed under separate cover to our address below. Provide the application and recommendations in the same envelop. **In replying front side only.**
2. We also ask that some evidence of good citizenship (volunteer activities or the like) be provided, with the submitted application.


