Scholarship Amount: 1 @ \$500

Criteria for awarding this scholarship:

- The recipient must be an FFA member and a graduate of USD #395, by the end of the school year, in which the scholarship is awarded.
- The recipient must have a cumulative high school grade point average of at least 3.0.
- The recipient will be selected on the basis of career vision and goals, leadership and community involvement, and financial need.
- Top priority will be given to the recipient that will study an agricultural-related major at a two or four year college as a full-time student.
- Two letters of recommendation are needed. It is recommended that one letter be written by the FFA Sponsor, and the other one can come from a high school teacher or a professional you have worked for or who knows your work ethic. Letters from family members or relatives will not be accepted.

Application Process: Submit completed application to the LHS Counselor, who in turn will submit all applications to the family of Danny J. Petz.

Application: Forms are due on or before April 5.

Payment: Recipient must notify Mrs. Petz the address of the college that you are attending, where the financial aid needs to be sent, along with your student ID number in order for the funds to be processed correctly. As soon as this is received, funds will be transferred to the college and a notification letter will be sent to the recipient.

Notification: The LHS Counselor will inform the recipient of selection. <u>A thank</u> you letter from the recipient is desired.
